2. Short Term Strategies: The following is an update on short term strategies as of April, 2008.

| #1 | At their quarterly meeting in July, Judge Flores will provide an informational briefing to all County Judges on the importance of a Methamphetamine treatment model that is appropriate for the needs of the abuser. | |
| #2 | CWS staff is currently scheduled for other Methamphetamine prevention training. Bob will contact CWS staff to learn who will provide the training and when it is scheduled. | |

4. While discussing the demonstration proposal, it was suggested that we develop a list of inquiries around the use of Title IV-E funds. Those inquiries could be sent to Congresswoman Capps or submitted to the Federal Lobbyist when he/she visits the County. Bob, Nancy and Ken Jensen will work together to develop those questions.
5. The final survey results were circulated and provided information on unmet needs for prevention, outreach and treatment in five different communities – Carpinteria, Santa Barbara, Lompoc, Santa Ynez and Santa Maria. There was a recommendation to develop a continuum of care strategy for the Santa Ynez Valley. PHP has potential space available for use by a treatment provider. The final recommendation to the Council should include treatment priorities that are consistent with all communities.
6. The presentation to the Council (July 9) will include the following:
 - a. Update on the judicial briefing re: Methamphetamine;
 - b. Update on Methamphetamine training provided for CWS workers;
 - c. Comments on the Demonstration proposal & possible questions to be asked of the Feds; and
 - d. Plans for developing a 'continuum of care' for treatment priorities for a specific community and overall for the County.
