1. Attendance: Lois Craig, Asia Eichmiller, and Bob Montgomery
2. Announcements: There was an extended meeting of the Policy Council prior to our meeting. Several of our members needed to continue with that meeting.
3. Short Term Strategies: The following is an update on short term strategies as of April, 2008.

Action Item	Description	Completed
#1	At their quarterly meeting in July, Judge Flores will provide an informational briefing to all County Judges on the importance of a Methamphetamine treatment model that is appropriate for the needs of the abuser.	
#2	Following our brief meeting, Bob met with the CWS manager in charge of the coordinating the proposed Methamphetamine training. CWS staff is currently scheduled for other Methamphetamine prevention training and it would probably be redundant to pursue the training previously considered by the Task Force. This item will be deleted from our short term strategies.	

4. The task force reviewed the demonstration project proposal that would provide funding for drug abuse treatment of intact families. It was suggested that the proposal include a more specific plan of how the treatment would be delivered. Bob will work with Heather to add that dimension to the proposal.
5. Asia provided a copy of the final survey results broken down by comment and area. In our telephone conference, we want to make a determination of what area should be considered in developing a comprehensive treatment of care proposal. A copy of that survey report is included with these minutes.
